Dear Families,

As we all get into the celebrations, it can also prove difficult for some families financially. If you are entitled to free school meals, we continue to give out vouchers until March next year. For the month of December these are £45 per child. If you think you may be entitled visit the link :www.norfolk.gov.uk/education-and-learning/schools/school-meals-and-milk.

In addition to the offer of FSM vouchers for eligible families, there is support available for families who are facing hardship and need support.

Anyone experiencing hardship may be able to receive support through the Norfolk Assistance Scheme (NAS), which may be able to provide support for food, fuel, clothes and other essential household items to families experiencing hardship. Wider support from a range of partners can then also be made available with NAS working alongside the Children's Services Community and Partnerships service.

Families may get in touch with NAS via their dedicated website at Norfolk Assistance Scheme - Norfolk County Council, which includes an online application form, or if they cannot access the internet, they can call **0344** 800 8020.

ALL PARENTS TO BE AWARE OF THE CHANGES

If your child attends our Pre-School, then please can you apply for your 30 Hour Funding Codes ready for January 2024, and return the funding forms that have already been sent home.

<u>Childcare Choices | 30 Hours Childcare, Tax-Free Childcare and More | Help with Costs |</u> GOV.UK

From 2 January 2024, eligible working parents can apply for 15 hours of childcare for their two-year-old. Parents have until 31 March 2024 to apply for a code, with mid-January to the end of February being the optimum time to apply in case they need to provide further information to support their application.

To apply for a childcare code each parent needs to be working and earning the equivalent of 16 hours a week at national minimum/living wage and under £100,000 adjusted net income per year. This means that each parent needs to earn from just over £8,600 per year to be eligible for 15 hours a week of childcare during term time.

There is more information on the childcare support available to parents on the <u>Childcare Choices</u> website, where they can explore the early education entitlements and other government help with childcare costs.
